
# Message from the Chairperson

# Madeline Singas



Nassau County District Attorney

A deep commitment to fairness, integrity, and justice guide Madeline Singas as Nassau County District Attorney, just as they have throughout her 25 year career as a prosecutor.

Elected in 2015, District Attorney Singas serves as the chief law enforcement official serving Nassau County's 1.3 million residents. She manages a staff of more than 350 attorneys, investigators, and support staff prosecuting and investigating approximately 30,000 criminal cases annually to ensure that Nassau remains one of the nation's safest suburban counties.

As District Attorney, Madeline has focused efforts on combatting drug and gun trafficking, violent gangs and sexual assaults. Using enhanced investigative techniques, collaborative partnerships and intelligence based prosecution models, she has effectively dismantled narcotics and gang enterprises within Nassau County and beyond its borders. She has dedicated unprecedented resources to battle the epidemic of heroin and opiate abuse plaguing Nassau County, prioritizing education to prevent addiction and treatment for those abusing drugs. In addition, she is committed to aggressively investigating and combatting government corruption to protect taxpayers from those who abuse the public trust.

Madeline's priorities are driven and informed by more than two decades of experience as a courtroom prosecutor, trying and overseeing thousands of criminal cases. She began her career as an Assistant District Attorney in Queens at the height of the crack wars, working her way through the ranks prosecuting murderers, batterers, and other violent criminals. In 2006, she joined the Nassau County District Attorney's Office as chief of Nassau's newly-created Special Victims Bureau, bringing her expertise to serve the most vulnerable victims—children, the elderly, and victims of domestic and sexual abuse.

In 2011, Madeline was appointed Chief Assistant District Attorney, and worked to design and implement specialized programs for adolescent offenders, veterans, and those who suffer from mental illness or drug addiction. She was elevated to the role of Acting District Attorney in January 2015, and elected to a four-year term in November 2015.

The daughter of Greek immigrants, Madeline grew up in Astoria. She is a graduate of the Bronx High School of Science, Barnard College at Columbia University, and Fordham University Law School. She lives in Manhasset with her husband and teenage twins.

Then, on December 5, 2016, with

She is a loving wife and a devoted mother of two, one of whom is a special needs miracle-daughter, Angela, and another a capable lawyer-son, Neal. She has a record of success in business, and since the 1990's has superbly served as the Administrator of The Law Firm of Ravi Batra, P.C., to assist in securing a full measure of merit-based justice in court and precedent-setting landmark victories. Working long hours is normal for her, as her dedication is beyond family and work, and includes social, civic, political and charitable activities. She has supported federal, state and local officials to help "form a more perfect union."

# Dr. Binita R. Shah

Dr. Binita R. Shah was bestowed upon the highest academic rank of Distinguished Teaching Professor of Emergency Medicine and Pediatrics in 2013 by the State University of New York (SUNY) Board of Trustees; Albany honoring her mastery of teaching. Dr. Shah was the only physician among the 5 professors chosen for Distinguished Teaching Professorship that year out of all 64 SUNY campuses. After completing pediatric residency and ambulatory care fellowship at SUNY Downstate in 1980, she served as a Director of Pediatric Emergency Room for 21 years at Kings

County Hospital Center; one of the largest city hospitals in NYC.

Dr. Shah has earned a national and international reputation through her highly acclaimed Pediatric books (5 books so far--). These books include: Atlas of Pediatric Clinical Diagnosis published in 2000 and Atlas of Pediatric Emergency Medicine (currently in its 3rd edition to be published in 2018). Her books are also translated into Portuguese and Spanish. Throughout her career, Dr. Shah has been an avid photographer, and over 2000 clinical photographs taken by her during her pediatric practice are published in these books. These books have been described as "classics" in their field and serve as a keystone of pediatric education both in the USA and abroad. Dr. Shah has received numerous prestigious awards for her contributions in the medical field including being inducted into the Alpha Omega Alpha medical honor society. Dr. Shah's guest for improving the quality of care delivered to critically ill and injured children globally has led her to travel to countries like Turkey, Brazil and India where she has tirelessly delivered powerful presentations at various medical conferences. In 2013, through All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS); New Delhi and INDO-US EM collaboration, Dr. Shah has played a monumental role voluntarily starting an online course for physicians interested in learning Pediatric EM to improve their skills serving critically ill children. Physicians from different countries (e.g. India, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia, UK) have successfully completed this on going course. Dr. Shah now regularly travels to reinforce their learning by organizing conferences in different cities in India.

Binita also has a passion for performing arts. In the early 1980s after settling in New Hyde Park, Binita and her husband Dr. Rajni P. Shah became ambassadors of Indian culture by organizing the first Indian Cultural Program at the Herrick's Community Center.

This program included presentation of Indian dances, a slide show entitled "Incredible India" and offered free Indian food tasting to all the attendees. Binita herself has performed in several prize winning performances in the FOGANA dance completions, at the International Dance Festival at Lincoln Center sponsored by the Gujarati Samaj of NY, and a dance ballet at Town hall, NYC sponsored by the Bhartiya Vidya Bhavan. She has also performed in several plays written and directed by her husband. Her signature performance as a motel owner housewife "Maniben" won her the best acting award in a drama competition hosted in NY.

Binita considers herself fortunate as her both children and their spouses are practicing in the field of medicine. She hopes that her 4 grandchildren one day will also carry forth the family's legacy of serving humanity through the practice of medicine.




