Neela Mukherjee Lockel, MSW-MPA, is the President and CEO of the EAC Network, overseeing programs across New York City and Long Island. The organizational pillars include: Seniors and Nutrition, Children and Youth, Families and Communities, Vocational Services and Criminal Justice and Behavioral Health. Neela has a long history of working with vulnerable populations with critical needs, and serving as a voice for those who are often unheard or unseen.

Before coming to the EAC Network, Neela served as the Chief Executive Officer of the American Red Cross on Long Island since 2016, where she oversaw Red Cross activities across Nassau County and Suffolk Counties and sat on the Regional Leadership Team of Greater New York. She facilitated the Regional Board Diversity Committee, was a member of the Advanced Public Affairs Training Team and the American Red Cross LEAD, an internal leadership development program. She deployed to several Red Cross disaster responses, and as the Interim Regional CEO for the Maine Region, to lead the team through a merger into the Northern New England Region.

Neela has over 25 years of experience in the non-profit sector from direct services and program development to advocacy to administration and leadership. She was the Founding Executive Director of Girls Inc. of Long Island. Prior to assuming this role in 2012, she worked in academia as an adjunct instructor at Stony Brook University and served as the Director of the Office of Continuing Education for the Adelphi University School of Social Work. She has also consulted with several organizations for strategic planning and program development.

Neela has been recognized numerous times for her achievements by several organizations, including: City and State's 50 Most Powerful People on Long Island, Nassau County Top Leaders, Long Island Press Power List, 40 Under 40 and Top 50 Women in Business by Long Island Business News; Leadership Award from the Shanti Fund and a Young Professionals Award from the American Heart Association.

Originally from New Jersey, Neela is now a resident of Suffolk County. She received an MPA in Public and Non-Profit Management from the NYU Wagner School of Public Service, an MSW from Fordham University, and a BA from Bates College. Neela is a Partner (2015) and Member of the Board of Advisors for the Energeia Partnership through Molloy College, and holds Executive Leadership Certificates from both Fordham University and Adelphi University's Center for Non-Profit Leadership. She is appointed to the Board of Directors for the Middle Country Library Foundation, the Long Island Association and the LIPA Community Advisory Board.

Neela is happily married to Dennis Lockel, retired NYPD, and has two children, Dylan and Dalilah in South Setauket, NY. She loves people, cooking, wellness, yoga and Sundays at home.

Then after seven years of govt service they started their own business in accessories and garments imported from India. Together they worked incessantly to support the family and the also look after the whole community. They took part in all organizations and community events in every religious and social Group to keep the community together. They were also the founders of the International Punjabi Society- a world recognized organization that bonded relations between India and US. Many political and famous dignitaries were hosted in these events including Giani Zail Singh and IK Gujral (Former Prime Ministers of India) that were introduced to all in the functions held at Mr. Premi's residence with Mrs. Premi being the backbone of all the events.

Mr. and Mrs. Premi took much pride in their incomparable ability to help the local community. they helped with anyone needing assistance. Mrs. Premi never had an issue with welcoming anyone into her home, and she would singlehandedly cook meals large groups of people at the drop of a hat. Many a times they housed people who had nowhere to go. Mrs. Premi helped new immigrants with Housing, providing shelter and guiding them in his new environment for several years. Their House was known as Mini Punjab.

What she became the most famous for was her sense of humor. She was a standup comedian and entertained all with her witty and spontaneous jokes.

Lastly and perhaps most importantly, she was a very generous and loving woman. She donated to many causes; most notably to foundations which focused on cancer research and aid to those who were blind, as they were close to her heart.

All in all, Sharan Premi was an amazing woman with qualities we all look for in those close to us, and even ourselves. She lived a long and full life, always surrounded by loved ones and good times, and she wouldn't have wanted it any other way. She is terribly missed, but we should all know she is watching over us and sending us all of her tremendous amounts of love.




