Doshi Smiles is the only fully family-funded organization of its kind and strives to one day become the foremost expert in the field of cranio-maxillofacial surgery under the capable stewardship of world-renowned visionary, Dr. Krishna Shama Rao. The project was initiated in May 2024 and has already performed over 1500 such surgeries at our centers located in India.

Countless underprivileged children and adults in developing countries face the often complex, sometimes even fatal, challenges associated with cleft lip, cleft palate, and other related facial birth deformities. Most struggles are due to a lack of education, access, funding, and societal stigma.

With every surgery and smile, we see patients regain normal function and confidence which brings hope of a bright future filled with promise and potential.







Pratima Bhullar Maldonado was born in India and migrated to the United States in March of 1994 at the age of 10. She earned her bachelor's degree in forensic psychology from John Jay College. In 2009, Pratima successfully completed her training at the NYPD Police Academy. She began her career as a rookie officer and served in the 79, 40, 41, and 49 precincts. She was later transferred in 2013 to the 115th precinct, located in Jackson Heights, a predominantly Indian community.

Pratima's proficiency in Punjabi, Hindi, and Urdu allowed her to effectively communicate with and represent the people of the community she served. With the support of the Sikh Officers Association, she generously dedicated her time to assisting the community in various capacities. Pratima was promoted to the rank of Sergeant in 2016 and assigned to the 50th Pct. She was later promoted to the rank of Lieutenant in 2018 and assigned to the 42nd Pct. These promotions marked significant departmental milestones. Pratima became the first female Sikh Sergeant and the first female Indian Lieutenant in NYPD history.

In March 2023, Pratima was promoted to the rank of Captain. This remarkable achievement marked her as the First South Asian Female Executive in the history of the NYPD, solidifying her reputation as a trailblazer. In February 2025, Pratima achieved yet another milestone in her career as she made history again by becoming the first South Asian female to serve as a Commanding Officer of a Police Precinct in the New York City Police Department.




